A Vision of Abundant Sustainability at College of the Atlantic

Jay Friedlander, Sharpe-McNally Chair of Green and Socially Responsible Business at College of the Atlantic (COA), articulates and enacts an innovative approach to education that is both inspiring and practical. Through the inclusion of community insights, collaborative learning, co-curricular opportunities, disciplinary knowledge, and practical application of course content, his courses provide students with frameworks and resources they draw on for years after graduation.

As a result, COA professors routinely work across disciplinary boundaries. As Nick Harris—2012 COA graduate and co-founder of Berkeley Yeast-reports, COA is a small school, with about 350 students and one professor in each discipline. He says the college has "knocked down all department separation; the professors collaborate with the students and are not siloed." As a professor at COA, Friedlander focuses on inviting the community and other types of knowledge into the classroom, "bringing together the subject and the world, thinking and doing." In this model, students interact with one other and the community, implementing the things they've learned by "practicing in situ" to "open new worlds of knowledge." Students thereby develop the skills to create ventures and organizations that can respond to complex, real-world needs.

Disrupting Preconceptions

Friedlander's approaches disrupt conventional thinking and often give students profound insights to use throughout their lives. For example, Friedlander reframes the concept of failure for his students. He says that when college students are taught that they have to succeed at everything, often they become risk-averse and fear failure. These attitudes, he notes, are not helpful for exploring new answers and finding new solutions. In all of his courses, Friedlander invites students to talk about things that go wrong. "What they think of as failure is life," he says. "The question is how you interface with it." He hastens to add that he's not encouraging people to fail recklessly; rather, he aims to help students understand that most things go wrong, and they need to be able to adjust and address missteps.

Friedlander also challenges the typical idea of sustainability; he views the idea as much richer than simply sustaining life. In his framework, sustainability stems from an "abundant mindset" and strives for inspiring ends: to heal the community, help people prosper, cause no harm, and repair the environment. The goal is to find ways to "recreate the world and do it in a way that is less harmful," he says.

The Hatchery

Friedlander runs the Diana Davis Spencer Hatchery Sustainable Enterprise Accelerator, one of a few venture incubators offering academic credit at an institution of higher education. Affectionately called "the Hatchery," this business accelerator course is equivalent to three classes, meaning that the single course represents full-time enrollment for the term. Students from multiple disciplines are represented in the class, and they focus on a variety of business types, including non-profit, scalable, and lifestyle businesses.

The class combines a post-disciplinary approach with hands-on practice; students develop expertise and business skills by actually creating businesses. Each year, five or six students take the class, and they have \$30,000 in start-up funds to split. They also have access to dedicated office space and mentors from the college and community. All of this support allows the students to fully focus on developing a business venture that aligns with their passions.



Friedlander's goal is not to pump out enterprises but to help students learn how to consider and weigh all factors in developing a business. He says that the course "is like a design squiggle—it's not linear; failure is baked in." As a result, success can take many forms in the Hatchery. Success could be continuing with the venture after graduation, but it might be deciding that it's a terrible idea, understanding why and what would need to change to make it viable.

One example Friedlander gives is of a student who had been very invested in the idea of a mobile slaughterhouse. This business would answer a community need, and the student had spent two years prior to the Hatchery developing the idea. Halfway through the Hatchery class, the student realized that he didn't want that business to be his life—and Friedlander classifies that careful examination of the idea, plus the final realization, as a success. The student also now carries deep insights about how to approach starting a business that he can apply to other opportunities.

Lifelong Benefits for Students

The Hatchery model has long-lasting and multiple effects on the students' lives, far beyond the one venture they develop, and for many years after graduation.

Harris, the COA alum, was part of an early Hatchery cohort and says he continues to draw on his work with Friedlander. He says he focused on chemistry in his studies at COA because he was interested in brewing beer, and he learned chemistry by sinking his teeth into this interest. Harris also took many of Friedlander's classes. In one yearlong class, teams were asked to go into the Mt. Desert Island community and identify business opportunities that could create positive change on the island. His team found that a great deal of organic waste was generated on the island, then trucked off as waste, while fuel was being trucked onto the island. His team settled on the concept of using an organic waste stream and fermentation to produce butanol, which is a "drop-in replacement for gasoline." This project shows how Friedlander encourages

students to interact with the community to imagine abundant sustainability.

In the next class that Harris took with Friedlander, he developed the business plan for Gourmet Butanol, with the tagline "Turn yesterday's eggplant parmesan into tomorrow's fuel." With the business plan developed, Harris applied for a NASA grant, which was funded. He was also funded for an EPA grant and won the sustainable business category of a statewide pitch competition. His business was also accepted to the Hatchery, which provided more funding and support. After graduation, he built a small butanol production facility at a community college in Colorado. At this point, he realized that the project would face many hurdles if it were to be realized on Mt. Desert Island, and it was bigger than he wanted to take on.

Even though Harris did not ultimately create the business, he says "it is hard to imagine a better learning experience." He recalls being fully supported by Friedlander throughout the process of exploring and

developing the business, learning to "think critically about issues and creatively about solutions." Harris eventually decided to pursue a PhD in microbiology at Berkeley, and "the application essay wrote itself" as he reported his educational experiences with Friedlander. He appreciates the ways that his entrepreneurial background helped in graduate school and wrote a successful National Science Foundation Graduate grant proposal that covered the program costs.

While still in graduate school, Harris teamed up with several other students to launch Berkeley Yeast, a company that genetically engineers yeast for the beer and wine industry. Because the yeast can convert the flavors, they can use hops that have been grown on marginal land and eliminate some of the energy-intense parts of the production process. Harris says that this business has allowed him to combine his passion for science with the entrepreneurship he learned from Friedlander. He is proud to be pushing

the beer and wine industry forward in this venture-backed business with 30 employees. He credits Friedlander with teaching him the things he needed to know to be successful in this business, and he uses those skills daily in his current role.

Another student who attributes his successes to Friedlander's mentorship is Surya Karki, co-founder and country director United World Schools Nepal and co-founder and sales and marketing director of Delish Dairies. He says that Friedlander is his "go-to person, mentor, and advisor." One of Friedlander's gifts, Karki notes, is that he answers questions with questions, not answers. Karki observes that this approach gave him the ability to question anything—class content, colleagues, himself.

In working with Friedlander and identifying his passions, Karki realized he had a "massive passion for education," and he wanted

to develop "lasting solutions to transform" education in Nepal. As a student, he established a foundation in the United States to support Nepalese education. During his junior year, he did an advanced independent study with Friedlander, focusing on creating a hybrid non-profit/ for-profit model for his project. He had to think about how to finance the solution, sustain the solution, and grow the solution to create more impact—skills and approaches he still uses today in his work.

In 2015, Karki took the Hatchery so that he could finally implement the model of building community schools in collaboration with the local government. His goal was to go to Nepal and build five schools, so he started fundraising for his low-cost, high-quality education model. Friedlander, he says, was his "constant supporter and critic." Karki was in Nepal in 2015 when the devastating earthquake struck. Friedlander, always focused on the community around a venture, asked how

they could galvanize support. Karki said they agreed to scale down their expectations and form an organization and fundraiser for an educational system to build back after the quake. When he graduated COA, Karki had contracts with donors for \$3 million over five years. UWS Nepal now works with over 13,0 rosalindfournier@gmail.com 00 students and has built—and continues to sustain—76 schools.

Karki appreciates that Friedlander "nurtures people with ideas, letting those ideas flourish." Friedlander also continues to mentor Karki, who is still developing new ventures. He recently started Delish, the first Greek yogurt company in Nepal, and he says that Friedlander is still asking questions he hadn't thought of yet.

The Human Ecology Lab in Osakikamijima (HELIO)

Friedlander has been deeply involved in

helping these approaches to education take root in Japan. After the Fukushima nuclear accident, the Japanese ministry of education determined that the accident was a failure of education—of planning safeguards, imagining what could go wrong, and figuring out how to respond to the myriad problems created by the event. Hiromi Nagao, a former university president in Japan, wanted to develop an educational system which would encourage students to look at the world in more complex ways, and she contacted COA to partner in this endeavor.

The partnership began in 2016 with a 10-day summer institute, the Human Ecology Lab and Island Odyssey (HELIO) in Osakikamijima, a small island on an inland sea. When COA started HELIO, about a third of the houses on Osakikamijima were vacant, and the majority of the population was over 60 years old. Island leaders were wondering how they could renew the economy

in a way that would ignite community from within. Students in the four HELIO programs have worked with the people on the island; they are there to learn from the people, not to be the experts imparting their knowledge. As Friedlander points out, the goal of such an education is not training people to be academics but finding ways to make the community more abundant.

The HELIO initiative has led to the establishment of Setouchi Global Academy, COA's new affiliate school on the Seto Inland Sea. According to a recent COA article, the school's mission aligns with Friedlander's approaches: "learning how to think critically and creatively, connecting to and contributing positively to the local community, learning about Japanese cultures, history, and traditions, and growing intellectually and emotionally through interactions and experiences."

Friedlander has crafted a model that works equally well for educational contexts and business ventures. In focusing on solving community problems collaboratively and creatively, he opens the doors to innovation and excitement. This educational vision not only prepares students to "face a world that's volatile," as he states; it also nurtures ways of thinking that can truly produce abundant sustainability around the world.

University Security Takes Center Stage: Six Things to Consider

With students returning to school for the spring semester, there's no time like the present to re-assess campus security and consider if the best protocols, staff, and technology are being used to ensure the safety of students, staff, and visitors. Deploying a combination of security technologies and policies, such as streamlining public entry/exit points, employing access-control systems, and making sure strategic intercoms and parking-lot emergency communication towers are in place can help colleges and universities improve their campus-wide security. Here are six things to consider.

1. Limit Building Entry Points

While many buildings on a university campus naturally have multiple entrance and exit points, universities should consider restricting access to one or two main entry/exit points for student and public access. This means that the majority of doors to a campus building should remain locked from the outside, accessible only in case of an emergency. Back entrance doors for use by designated personnel should include an entry-control system that requires

the use of an access control credential such as an access control badge or key pin. This will also create an access control log that can provide useful data in the future.

2. Use Intercoms to Keep the Front Office Secure

The main advantage of funneling building access to a central entrance point is that it allows university staff to screen visitors before permitting them to enter. In some buildings,

such a secure science building or floor in a science building, visitors can enter the lobby but need to be vetted by the front office before gaining full access to the building. To assist with this process, colleges have installed intercom systems that enable the building staff to communicate with a visitor first before unlocking a door to allow that person to enter. Intercom systems that include an IP video camera enable staff or security personnel to visually verify the identity of an individual. It can also help to see if a visitor is carrying any weapons or if a person is agitated in any way so that staff can contact security if there is a safety concern.

3. Invest in an Access Control System

A lock and key are no longer enough to keep a college building secure or to manage building access. This is especially true in dormitory settings, where it's recommended that universities invest in an access control system that can safely manage entrances and generate access control reports. With an access control system in place, colleges and universities can

keep a dormitory safe and secure by ensuring only students who live there can gain access at any time. For academic buildings, an access control system helps easily manage when a staff member has access to a building, such as limiting access during the hours of 1 a.m. to 5 a.m., or revoking access privileges when an employee no longer works for the university. An access control system can also generate an alert and send a notification to campus security when a door does not close properly, an obvious threat to the security of the building and its occupants.

4. Leverage Visitor Management Tools

University campuses are bustling environments consisting of a variety of people, from students and professors to prospective students and their families touring campus or even vendors. Knowing who is in a building at any given time and the length of their visit can be a challenge to track using old-fashioned paper

logs. Many access control systems today come with visitor management capabilities and the ability to create temporary visitor credentials that can restrict a visitor's access to certain areas of a building when used in conjunction with a door entry control system. The visitor credentials can also be programmed to send a notification to staff if the visitor doesn't return to the main entrance by a certain time to log out.

5. Integrate Multiple Security Systems

Security technology should never be siloed, with systems operating independently of one another. Instead, campus security directors should look to integrate systems wherever possible to take full advantage of the information connected systems provide. One overlooked integration opportunity includes integrating video from a video intercom system with a third-party video management system. By connecting video from a video

intercom system used at a building entry point campus with the video-management system (VMS), campus security gains seamless access to that video and recording capabilities.

6. Secure Parking Lots with **Emergency Towers**

While much of the focus on university security zeroes in on buildings, it's also important to remember that parking lots and parking garages also need security tools. Parking structures are often quite large, void of many people, and located away from a physical

building, making them a safety threat. In a large parking garage or expansive surface lots, the ability to find help in the event of an emergency can prove to be very difficult. A reliable, network-connected emergency tower can be easy to locate thanks to their tall design and bright colors.

When someone presses a button on an emergency tower, the person on the receiving end knows exactly where that tower is located, taking the guesswork out of trying to pinpoint a location in a sea of vehicles. In the event of an emergency, when a video intercom system paired with an emergency tower is located inside a parking garage it allows a security officer to speak with the individual who is calling about an emergency. An optional overhead camera attachment can also provide a bird's-eye view of the person in distress.

University security has made significant advancements over the past few decades thanks to continuous investments in technology. Ensuring the safety of individuals on a college campus remains an ongoing concern that necessitates regular reviews of the technologies deployed and the maintenance of best practices in building safety and access policies.



Security

Failing to properly secure vehicle keys is a major risk. For example, if a fleet department stores keys on a pegboard or in a basic lockbox, anyone who accesses the area can easily remove a key, regardless of if they're authorized to do so, and access a fleet vehicle.

Unauthorized use of fleet vehicles not only interferes with routine university operations but also increases the institution's liability risk. For example, someone recklessly driving a branded university vehicle puts others at risk and endangers the university's reputation. In addition, if the vehicle is involved an accident, it can lead to higher insurance costs and pose legal risks, especially if the university's key control practices are inadequate.

Key Control Strategies

- Secure keys properly: Instead of a pegboard or lockbox, fleet managers should consider an electronic key management system that secures all keys in tamper-proof steel drawers or solid wall-mounted panels that lock down each key individually. Key control technology enhances security by restricting access to authorized personnel only, reducing the risks and costs associated with misplaced or stolen keys and vehicles.
- Automatically authenticate drivers: A key control system should require drivers to scan a fingerprint, enter a PIN, or swipe a card to gain access to keys.
- Enable security alerts: A system should be able to alert managers in real time via text or email if someone tries to take a key without proper authorization or fails to return a key within a specific time frame. These measures help ensure immediate action in the event of unauthorized key access, encourage employees to practice good stewardship of keys, and protect the university from liability.

Rising Costs

Tens of thousands of dollars go toward modifications, maintenance, fuel, and more over the course of a vehicle's fleet life. Fleet managers are tasked with achieving readiness rates year in and year out as costs climb and budgets shrink.

If an institution is operating on a limited budget, there's no room for inefficiency. When evaluating cost-saving measures, eliminating time-consuming manual key control processes is a good place to start. This issue alone wastes valuable resources,

from lost productivity to key replacement costs. A process that requires someone to manually sign keys in or out delays staff or faculty getting the vehicles they need. That's not to mention the interruptions throughout the fleet manager's day when they need to

check a key in or out. Errors or omissions on the key log lead to further complications.

Another significant source of cost inefficiencies is maintenance, which is only compounded by supply chain challenges. To extend vehicle lifespans and avoid costly repairs, timely maintenance is crucial. Inadequate maintenance drives up costs as over-worked vehicles face emergency roadside repairs or pricey part replacements.

Monitoring a fleet's high-use vehicles is a priority since they often require the most maintenance. However, it's important not to forget vehicles that tend to stay on the lot. When vehicles are stagnant, tires can rot, batteries can degrade, fuel can go bad, and fluid leaks can develop.

Key Control Strategies

- Digitize key logs: To save time and ensure an accurate key log, electronic key control systems can automatically record who took a key, when, and why. With accurate key logs, fleet managers are better equipped to right-size the fleet, maintain timely maintenance schedules, and achieve a high readiness rate.
- Enter vehicle mileage upon key return: Key control systems can prompt users to enter mileage when they return a key, helping fleet managers streamline maintenance schedules. Managers can then review daily reports to find discrepancies and track maintenance.
- Review key activity logs to identify underor overutilization: The data key control systems generate, such as usage patterns and mileage records, helps inform decision making. By having access to detailed reports, fleet managers can make strategic choices regarding budget allocation, maintenance schedules, and vehicle assignments.
- Reserve keys when vehicles are due for maintenance: When a vehicle is approaching a mileage milestone, fleet managers can reserve that key to temporarily remove the vehicle from rotation.

Sustainability

Universities rely heavily on their fleets for various functions. However, excessive use increases fuel consumption, which not only strains the university's budget but also contributes to higher carbon emissions, amplifying the institution's environmental impact.

Unnecessary use also accelerates wear and tear on vehicles, reducing their overall lifespans. Addressing these sustainability challenges is difficult if drivers put "mystery miles" on vehicles, using them without permission or for unauthorized reasons.

Key Control Strategies

Track key usage patterns to optimize utilization: Key control systems' ability to automatically record who took a key, when, and why provides a comprehensive overview of fleet utilization. With this data, fleet managers can allocate resources efficiently to achieve sustainability objectives and foster responsible fleet management practices.

- · Review mileage history to identify wasteful use: By enabling precise tracking of fleet keys, electronic key control helps reduce wasteful fleet use. Fleet managers can detect mystery miles by comparing mileage accrued on a vehicle against the checkout reason provided.
- Assign vehicles based on job roles to conserve resources: To prevent unnecessary wear and tear on vehicles and reduce fuel emissions, fleet managers can restrict access to certain vehicles based on job roles. For example, a recruiter would be able to check out a fuel-efficient sedan but not a van.

Using technology to improve key management empowers fleet managers to enhance campus safety, optimize operations for better cost control, and promote responsible resource management. With effective key control, university fleets can continue to drive campus operations forward for years to come.







Fostering Performance Flexibility at Wartburg College

At Wartburg College, the integration of Wenger's Transcend™ Active Acoustic System has been a game-changer. Wartburg faced the challenge of revamping its Neumann Auditorium, a dated venue initially designed for spoken-word events and religious services. Because the acoustics were extremely dry, it was a difficult performance space for Wartburg's choral groups, often singing classical works intended for cavernous, cathedral-like spaces. 






enabling optimization for both choral and instrumental performances. The system also ensures a more consistent sound throughout the auditorium. Every Neumann audience member—even those under the balcony—enjoys great sound quality.






ENERGY STAR®Certified Commercial Cooking Equipment

No matter the size of the foodservice operation on your campus, greater efficiency leads to greater profits. This is especially true in the kitchen, where utilizing energy-efficient equipment is the most effective way to manage monthly bills. But running a sustainable kitchen is not just about reducing energy, water and waste expenses. The impact is much broader – these choices have the power to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and protect our climate.

Fortunately, cooking with energy efficient equipment doesn't mean sacrificing on features, quality or performance. In fact, ENERGY STAR® certified cooking equipment helps operators save money and protect the environment.

In order to earn the ENERGY STAR label, products must meet the energy efficiency requirements set forth by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

There are currently eight commercial foodservice (CFS) product categories:

Commercial Refrigerators and Freezers: to qualify, refrigerators and freezers must be 40% more energy efficient than standard models. Certified products are designed with components that result in more uniform cabinet temperatures and reduced heat output from more efficient compressor systems. There are a variety of eligible products in this category including reach-in, roll-in, pass-through, undercounter, milk coolers and more. A certified commercial freezer may save an operator \$200-\$430/year in estimated energy costs while a certified commercial refrigerator may save an operator \$100/year.

Commercial Dishwashers: to qualify, dishwashers must be 40% more energy efficient and 40% more water efficient than standard models. Many certified dishwashers offer features such as dish load sensors, low power mode during long periods of idle and improved nozzle and rinse arm design. Both stationary and conveyor machines are eligible. Certified dishwashers have a huge impact on an operator's bottom line. Flight-type dishmachines may save an operator \$5,500/ year in estimated energy costs. Other eligible dishmachines may save an operator \$1,300/year.

Commercial Ice Makers: to qualify, ice makers must be 12% more energy efficient and 23% more water efficient than standard models. Both batch-type machines and continuous-type machines are eligible

and new models offer technical improvements over older models such as improved evaporator insulation and high efficiency compressors, fan motors and water pumps. Batch-type machines may save an operator \$125/year in estimated energy costs while continuous-type machines may save \$185.

Commercial Fryers: to qualify, fryers must be 30% more energy efficient than standard models. Gas and electric open vat fryers – both countertop and floor type – are eligible, as long as the frypot is greater than 12 inches and less than 24 inches. Advanced technologies such as new heat exchanger designs and more accurate thermostats lead to higher production, quicker recovery and an overall extended product lifetime. Depending upon size of the tank, gas fryers have the potential to save operators \$460-\$520/year in estimated energy costs while electric fryers may save operators \$120-\$185.

Commercial Griddles: to qualify, griddles must be 10% more energy efficient than standard models. Operators who switch to gas or electric certified models will enjoy improved cooking performance, higher productivity and improved temperature uniformity across the plate. Within the industry, highly conductive plate materials as well as improved thermostatic controls are readily available. A gas griddle may save an operator \$100/year in estimated energy costs while an electric griddle may save operators \$130/year.

While energy efficient equipment may have a larger price tag than other models at the time of purchase, it will be offset by each year of use of the more efficient equipment. Additionally, some utility providers offer a rebate for purchasing more efficient equipment. Be sure to check with your local provider.

It is estimated that outfitting an entire kitchen with a suite of ENERGY STAR certified equipment could save an operator about 360 MBtu/year – or the equivalent of \$5,000 per year. When this is considered in context of the number of kitchens on a campus, it is truly staggering. And what's more, full ENERGY STAR certified equipment would prevent about 42,000 pounds of greenhouse gas emissions annually.
